


### RAISING THE STANDARD AND ACCELERATING ACTION GLOBALLY

- Launched in 2025: <u>GSC–JCI Healthcare Sustainability</u> <u>Certification</u> (HSC) programme for hospitals willing to demonstrate additional efforts.


